Explore the region's rich history with trips that combine a visit to local heritage sites.

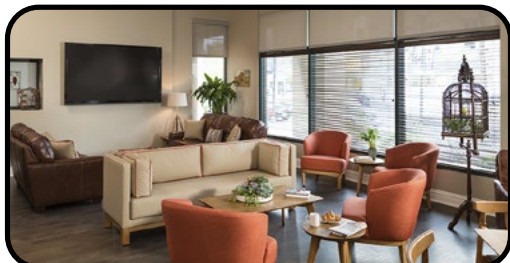
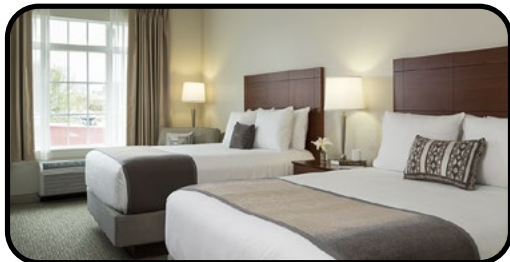
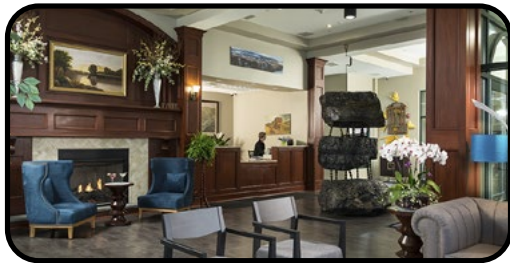
Hotel Anthracite is a boutique hotel in downtown Carbondale that offers all the amenities of the present, with a respectful nod to the past.
