The Historic Hawley Silk Mill

Built in 1880 by Dexter, Lambert & Co., at a cost of \$130,000. The High Victorian Gothic-style structure is on the National Register of Historic Places and is considered the largest bluestone building in the world.

Today, it hosts a variety of unique small shops, a gym, a bakery, art galleries, offices, and Lackawanna College. View the incredible Paupack High Falls right outside our venue, The Boiler Room.






