The Roatan Institute for Marine Sciences is excited to offer a 5-week Dolphin Training & Research Internship this summer. The program is open to upper level undergraduates or recent graduates and will be limited to 12 interns. Interns will live and work at our facility and gain valuable research and field experience as they get to know our resident population of bottlenose dolphins and receive an invaluable introduction into the training process.



Under the direction of a senior dolphin trainer/biologist, interns will engage in a wide variety of activities and gain experience and skills that will make them more competitive when pursuing future employment and research opportunities in the field of marine mammal science. Internss will:

- Receive in-depth lectures on a variety of topics including evolution, anatomy, physiology, echolocation, reproduction, cognition, communication, conservation, and social dynamics.
- Utilize field research methods to observe and record behavioral interactions.
- Learn marine mammal training techniques.
- Assist in dolphin husbandy and animal care management.
- Develop and implement an independent research project.
- Interact with an extremely dedicated and caring team of marine mammal professionals.

Eligibility & Terms

We do not offer course credit for the program but we encourage successful applicants to arrange for research or independent studies credit through their home institution.

Costs
