DARK AND DECADENT

- Great Lakes Edmund Fitzgerald, American Porter, Cleveland, OH** 6.5
Brewed in memory of the sunken freighter, with rich roasted barley and bittersweet chocolate-coffee notes. 5.8% 37 IBU
- Harviestoun Old Engine Oil, Porter, Alva, SCO** 11.75
A deliciously creamy, velvety English porter with notes of coffee, toffee, dark chocolate, and slight hop presence. A must try! 6% 40 IBU
- Orkney Skullsplitter, Scotch Ale, Orkney Islands, SCO** 10.
Notes of molasses, dried fruit, and toasted malt—a wine-like complexity on the palate. Pairs well with beef and game dishes... if you dare! 8.5% 19 IBU
- Unibroue Trois Pistoles, Belgian Style Strong Dark, Quebec, CAN** 10.
Malt, raisins, chocolate, and molasses aromas. Decadent! 9% 16 IBU
- Weyerbacher Tiny, Belgian Style Imperial Stout** 8.5
This smooth beer has big chocolate and roasted notes, balanced with the Belgian flavors from the Abbey yeast strain. 11.8% 36 IBU

BELGIAN BEAUTIES

- Bosteels Tripel Karmeliet, Belgian Tripel, Buggenhout, BEL** 13.
Three grain brew of oats, barley and wheat give a rich character, with flavors of vanilla and banana and a slight hop bitterness. A 17th Century recipe after the Carmelite monks. 8.4% 16 IBU
- Huyghe Delerium Tremens, Belgian Strong Pale Ale, Melle, BEL** 13.5
The term “Delerium Tremens” or the “DTs” was first used in 1813, and literally translates to “going off the furrow”. A great golden ale, with spicy light fruit aromas, malt flavors, and a dry finish. Pairs perfectly with pink elephants. The most recognized Belgian Triple in the world! 2.8± 50 IBU
- La Trappe, Belgian Style Quadrupel, Berkel-Enschot, NED** 13.5
The strongest of the special beers and also the most revered beer from this seventh Trappist brewery actually in the Netherlands. Its flavor is full, mild and pleasantly bitter. 10% 22 IBU
- Ommegang 3 Philosophers, Fruited Quadrupel, Cooperstown, NY** 12.5
A glorious blend of Belgian-style quadrupel and authentic Belgian kriel, its malty depth and gentle sweetness enhanced by sparkling carbonation and a serendipitous touch of cherry. 9.7% 19 IBU
- St. Bernardus ABT 12, Belgian Quadrupel, Watou, BEL 25oz** 24.
Notes of honey, toffee, coffee, dried figs & dates. 10.5% 22 IBU
- Victory Merry Monkey, Fruited Tripel, Downingtown, PA** 7.75
Golden Monkey (Belgian Tripel) is used as a base, to which pops of cranberry, orange peel, cinnamon and nutmeg are added. 10% 35 IBU
- Westmalle Dubbel, Belgian Double, Antwerp, BEL** 13.75
Westmalle Abbey was founded in 1794, and has been brewing since 1836. It is one of only seven Trappist breweries in the world, and is renowned for defining the Dubbel style. Amber-brown in color, with caramel, malt, and fruity ester notes. Beautiful lacing and a long, dry finish. Bottle conditioned and vegan. 7% 24 IBU
